## Your child's safety is of paramount importance to us!

- Every Bible Club teacher must complete an extensive application and be approved by our Board of Directors.
- A thorough background check by the Michigan State Police is performed on every worker. Each worker is also screened through the National Sex Offender database.
- Every Bible Club worker is required to complete training on child protection.
- Each teacher wears an official Boys and Girls Bible Clubs photo identification badge during all activities.
- Every Bible Club teacher is required to read our "Safeguarding our Children" Child Protection policy each year.
- Children are strongly encouraged to use the restroom before or after Bible Club.
- Once children arrive for Bible Club they are not allowed to roam the halls.
- When Bible Club is dismissed, workers lead the students to the outside door and stay with them until every child has left, according to your instructions.
- All Bible Clubs are planned so several adult teachers are visible as they work with the children. Activities occur in public places to minimize the risk of anyone being alone with a child.
